- 4.1 A copy of License of the applicant to which the special operation relates;
- 4.2. The names and addresses of the applicant's significant owners and directors, if any;
- 4.3. The Official Registered Address of the applicant in Kosovo
(Business Registration Certificate)
- 4.4. A description of the technical, professional and managerial capabilities of the personnel to be principally responsible for the conduct of the special operation, including a copy of their CV and, as may reasonably be required by the ICMM, all relevant diplomas, licenses and certificates:
- 4.5. The proposed route of access by the applicant to such area, and the boundaries of each concerned Municipality
- 4.6. If the applicant provides for undertaking activities under items a) b) and f) Table 1, should also bring surface rights agreement(s), having a duration of not less than the proposed Permit, between the applicant and all third parties having lawfully registered property rights to the surface area that the applicant proposes to use during the conduct of the concerned special operations; or evidence of refusal or failure of such third parties to enter into such an agreement on reasonable terms,
- 4.7. A rehabilitation program prepared in each case by suitably qualified and experienced experts;
- 4.8. Such other documentation as the ICMM may reasonably require.

Copies shall also be carried by operators on equipment that is operated off the site and shall be available at any and all times for inspection by either:

The holder of this Permit as the employer is obliged to implement health and safety measures according to EU Directive 89/391/EEC and any other EU Regulations within the meaning of Article 16 (1) of this EU Directive and any valid Law and Kosovo Laws as promulgated from time to time.
